- Community-driven solutions for long-term water security



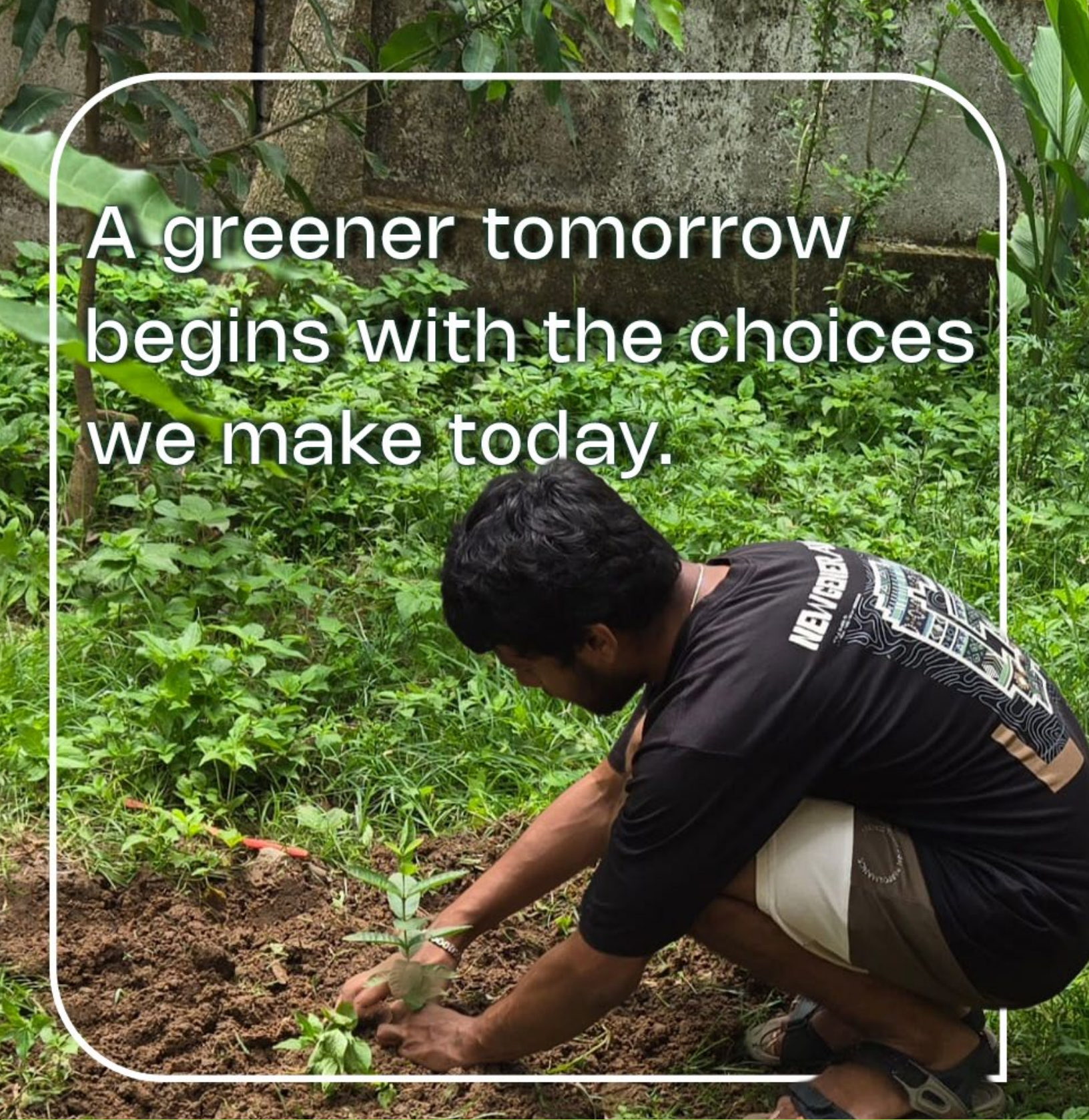
PROJECT FOOTBALL FOR ALL FOUNDATION
